Key findings

Restore Technology is the public-sector incumbent.

It holds five of the tracked contracts across police, councils and central bodies — the only supplier with repeat wins in three buyer segments.

Most of the money is in mixed waste, not pure ITAD.

The largest award (£4.16m, Northern Ireland Water) is skip, scrap and WEEE. Pure IT disposal is about a fifth of disclosed value.

Buyers cannot see prices.

Of 22 named winners, only TFix publishes unit rates. Every incumbent is quote-only.

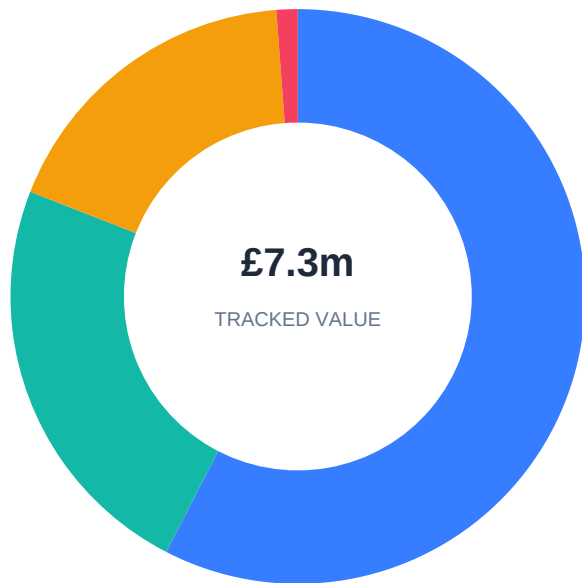
Five contracts return to market within 12 months.

Two expire this month — LB Hillingdon and the Office for Students data-destruction contract.

Methodology & sources

Find a Tender (Procurement Act 2023) and Contracts Finder, both under the Open Government Licence. Selection by ITAD / WEEE / data-destruction keywords and relevant CPV codes. Values ex-VAT as disclosed; 'not disclosed' excluded from totals. The £200m YPO framework is a multi-supplier agreement, reported separately.
